

OUR HISTORY, OUR VOICE VIDEO CONTEST OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE OR CONSIDERATION NECESSARY TO PARTICIPATE, ENTER OR WIN. MAKING A PURCHASE WILL NOT IMPROVE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

ALL DISPUTES WILL BE RESOLVED SOLELY BY BINDING ARBITRATION AND ENTRANTS WAIVE THE ABILITY TO BRING CLAIMS IN A CLASS ACTION FORMAT.

By participating in Our History, Our Voice Video Contest (the “Contest”), each participant (“Participant”) unconditionally accepts and agrees to comply with and abide by these Official Rules and the decisions of The Center on Asian Americans and the Law, and AAPI Crime Victims and Education Fund (the “Sponsors”) and Votigo, Inc. (the “Administrator”), which shall be final and binding in all respects.

DATES OF THE CONTEST: The Contest starts at 12:00 AM Eastern Time (“ET”) on November 7, 2024, and ends at 11:59 PM ET June 30, 2025 (the “Contest Period”). The Contest Period is divided into an entry period, a public polling period and a judging period. The entry period starts at 12:00 AM ET on November 7, 2024 and ends at 11:59 PM ET on March 31, 2025 (the “Entry Period”). The public polling period starts at 12:00 AM ET on April 1, 2025 and ends at 11:59 PM ET on April 30, 2025 (the “Polling Period”). The judging period starts May 1, 2025 and ends on June 30, 2025 (the “Judging Period”), after which the winners will be announced.

ELIGIBILITY: The Contest is open to legal residents of the United States and the District of Columbia and territories who are between the ages of 13 and 18 and currently enrolled in middle school or high school at the time of entry. Void outside the U.S. and wherever else prohibited by law. Employees of the Sponsors, Administrator and their respective subsidiaries, affiliates, advertising and promotion agencies, and the immediate family members (spouses, parents, children, and siblings and their spouses) of, and/or those living in the same household of each, are not eligible to enter. Contest is subject to all applicable federal, state, provincial and local laws and regulations.

HOW TO ENTER: During the Entry Period:

- Visit <https://asianamericanhistory.votigo.com/> (the “Contest Site”) and select one of the legal cases listed.
- Create a video introducing and highlighting the impact of the selected case in a thoughtful and creative way that will bring attention to this event in Asian American legal history. (the “Video”);
- Then visit the Contest Site and follow all entry instructions to complete the entry form, upload your Video and submit to receive one (1) entry into the Contest (the “Entry” or “Video”).

Entries must be received between November 7, 2024 at 12:00:01 AM ET and December 10, 2024 at 11:59:59 PM ET. Entrants are subject to all notices posted online including but not limited to the Administrator's Privacy Policy, which can be found at <https://www.votigo.com/corp/privacy.php>

There is a limit of one (1) Entry per person, per case regardless of whether entrant has more than one email address. Each Entry must include an original Video. Entries submitted with a Video that has already been submitted will be disqualified. Although subsequent attempts to enter may be received, only the first complete entry received from a particular entrant will be eligible; subsequent attempts by the same person to enter, including entries submitted with an alternate email address, will be disqualified.

Entries will be posted to a public gallery within the Contest Website (the "Contest Gallery"). The Sponsor will review all submitted Entries prior to such Entries being published and reserves the right in its sole and absolute discretion to reject, disqualify and/or remove any Entry that violates these Official Rules without any notification or warning. Posting to the Contest Gallery does not indicate the Entry has complied with the Official Rules. Sponsor reserves the right to post sample Videos it has created in connection with the Contest. Sponsor does not guarantee the posting of any Entry.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS & CONDITIONS: All Entries must comply with the following minimum guidelines to be eligible:

- If individuals other than the Entrant appear in the Video, Entrant must have express permission from all individuals. If Video features a minor under the age of majority in his/her state of residence, Entrant must obtain written permission from the minor's legal guardian.
- Entries must be in one of the following formats: AVI, MOV, WMV, MP4, MPEG, FLV, 3GP, and 3G2; must be under 400MB and must be no longer than three (3) minutes.
- Video must be Entrant's original idea (modification of an original work is not an original idea). Entries must not copy or otherwise plagiarize from any source and must utilize public materials.
- Video cannot contain content that is irrelevant to the purpose of the Contest.
- Once a Video has been submitted, it cannot be modified or deleted by Entrant.
- Each submitted Video must be original, on which no image editing software has been used.
- No duplicate Videos or substantially similar Videos, as determined by the Sponsor's in its sole discretion, may be submitted.
- By submitting a Video taken by a third party, Entrant warrants and represents that he/she has secured all rights and clearances to the Video from the videographer.
- Video must not contain content that is known by you to be false, inaccurate or misleading.
- Any Video deemed inappropriate or unsuitable, in Sponsor's sole discretion, will be disqualified. Video must not contain material that is inappropriate, indecent (including, but not limited to, nudity, or pornography), profane, obscene, hateful, tortious, defamatory, slanderous, libelous (including words or symbols that are widely considered offensive to individuals of a certain race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, or socioeconomic group), violent (e.g., relating to murder, the sales of weapons, cruelty, abuse, etc.), or illegal (e.g., underage drinking, substance abuse, computer hacking, etc.).

- The Video must not contain or depict material that promotes bigotry, racism, hatred or harm against any group or individual or promotes discrimination, including without limitation, discrimination based on race, sex, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation or age. The Video must not contain or depict material that is threatening to any person, place, business, group, or world peace or contain words or symbols that are widely considered offensive to individuals of a certain race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, or socioeconomic group.
- The Video must not contain any content that infringes or may infringe third party rights, including, without limitation, any copyright, name, trademark, logo, trade dress, or other personal or proprietary right of any person living or deceased (including but not limited to rights of privacy or publicity or portrayal in a false light) or entity or make reference to any commercial/corporate advertising (including but not limited to corporate logos, brand names, charities, slogans, political, or religious statements), or be otherwise objectionable. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, publicly displayed and publicly accessible Sponsor content, materials, or products are permitted to be displayed in Entries submitted for this Contest.
- Videos must not include music protected by a copyright (unless this is music that you own or have the rights to use).
- Video must not include any representation of celebrities, athletes, musicians, or any other third-party (public or private), include any anti-social, political or religious groups, any commercial solicitation or promotional materials or name, address, phone number, or URL address. Entries must not contain advertisements, personal solicitations or commercial solicitations.
- All submitted Videos must be in keeping with Sponsor's image as determined by Sponsor, in its sole discretion, or entry will be disqualified from the Contest. The Video must not disparage persons or organizations associated with Sponsor.
- Video must not have been submitted previously in a giveaway or promotion of any kind or previously exhibited or displayed publicly (i.e., disclosed beyond your immediate circle of friends and family) through any means.
- Entries may not be created with the assistance of any Artificial Intelligence tools or any other form of generative technology ("AI"). This includes supplementary materials. Any Entry that has been determined to have used AI or any other form of generative technology at the sole determination of Sponsors will be disqualified

By submitting an Entry, the Entrant understands and grants to the Sponsor an irrevocable, perpetual, non-exclusive worldwide license to use his/her Entry, Video, name, hometown and likeness on the Sponsor's various websites and social media sites and in advertising and/or promotional activities worldwide without compensation, permission or notification. Sponsor reserves the right in its sole and absolute discretion to alter, change or modify any Entry or Video.

By submitting an Entry, Entrant warrants and represents that: (a) Entry and Video do not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity or other intellectual property or other legal or moral rights of any person or entity; (b) Entrant has obtained written permission from any person who may appear in the Video; (c) Entrant owns all rights to the Video, including without limitation, copyrights, and has received prior written permission from a third party if any Video was videoed by someone other than the Entrant him/herself; and (d) Entrant will indemnify and hold harmless the Sponsor, Administrator

and related entities, agents and assigns from any claims and damages (including reasonable attorneys' fees) arising from or relating to the breach or alleged breach of your representations and warranties herein, the Entry, or Entrant's conduct in creating the Entry, the acceptance or use of any prize or otherwise in connection with this Contest.

ENTRIES POSTED TO THE CONTEST WEBSITE ARE THE VIEWS/OPINIONS OF THE INDIVIDUAL ENTRANT AND DO NOT REFLECT THE VIEWS OF SPONSOR IN ANY MANNER.

PRIZES/APPROXIMATE RETAIL VALUE ("ARV):

Grand Prize: There is one (1) Grand Prize available to be won. One (1) Grand Prize winner will receive \$5,000 USD issued in the form of a check. The ARV of Grand Prize: \$5,000 USD.

First Prize: There are three (3) First Prizes available to be won. Each First Prize winner will receive \$1,000 USD issued in the form of a check. The ARV of First Prize is \$1,000 USD.

The total ARV of all prizes available to be won: \$8,000 USD.

There is a limit of one (1) prize per person.

POLLING: During the Polling Period, all legal US residents physically residing in the 50 United States and District of Columbia who are between the ages of 13 and 18 and currently enrolled in middle school or high school at the time of polling will have the opportunity to vote for their favorite Entries by visiting the Website and following the on-screen instructions to register and vote for an Entry. Limit one (1) vote per person, per day. This contest will be determined by the judging panel, but members of the public will have the opportunity to make their opinions known subject to the rules governing the Polling Period. Sponsor reserves the right to nullify any votes made through use of robotic, macro, automatic, programmed, proxy votes or like methods and to disqualify the responsible individual, in Sponsor's sole discretion. Entrants are prohibited from manipulating or influencing the polling by any inappropriate means, including, but not limited to, offering prizes or other inducements to members of public, paying a third-party service to vote in the poll, collaborating with other individuals or groups to trade votes, utilizing paid media amplification, or otherwise acting in contravention of these Official Rules, as determined by Sponsor, in its sole discretion, and Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify the responsible Entrant and his/her Entry from the Contest. Votes sent from foreign IP addresses may be disqualified, in Sponsor's sole discretion.

JUDGING & WINNER DETERMINATION: During the Judging Period, all eligible Entries received during the Contest Entry Period will be judged by a panel appointed by the Sponsors, who shall use the criteria set forth below:

Effectiveness & Creativity: Effectiveness of the video in communicating the story and impact of the case. The Video will be judged based on how interesting, engaging and creative it is in its retelling of the case.

- **40% - Effectiveness** - The effectiveness of the video in communicating the story and impact of the case.

- **25% - Creativity:** The extent to which the video is interesting, creative, and engaging.
- **25% - Visual Appeal:** Aesthetic impact and technical mastery of video media
- **10% - Polling:** The panel of judges will take into account the results of the public polling

The Entry that receives the highest total score based on the judging criteria will be deemed the potential Grand Prize winner. The Entry that receives the second through fourth highest total scores based on the judging criteria will be deemed the First Prize winners. In the unlikely event of a tie, the tied Entry with the highest score in Criteria A, will be deemed the potential winner. If additional tie breakers are needed, the tie-breaking mechanism above will be used; however, instead of the highest score in Criteria A determining the potential finalists from among the tied entries, the highest scores in each of Criteria B through D, in sequence (to the extent needed) will determine the potential winner. In the event additional tiebreakers are needed, all tied Entries will be judged by a separate panel of judges using the judging criteria above.

WINNER NOTIFICATION & VERIFICATION:

Potential Grand Prize and First Prize winners will be notified by the Administrator via email and/or phone, and will be required to sign and return, within seven (7) days of notification, an Affidavit of Eligibility, a Liability Waiver, and where allowable, a Publicity Release (collectively, "the Releases"), Noncompliance will result in disqualification and an alternate winner will be selected.

Prize winners will be required to complete and return an IRS W-9 Form and furnish his/her Social Security Number for the sole purpose of tax reporting, as required by law. Noncompliance will result in disqualification and an alternate winner may be selected.

If a prize notification or prize is returned as undeliverable, or if winner is found to be ineligible or not in compliance with these rules that winner will be disqualified, and the prize may be awarded to the Entrant with the next highest judging score. If Sponsor is unable to determine and verify a potential winner after repeated notifications or if Sponsor fails to receive a sufficient number of entries to correspond to the number of prizes available to be awarded, Sponsor reserves the right to not award such prize(s).

PRIZE CONDITIONS: Prizes are not assignable nor transferable.

Prize Winners are responsible for all federal, state, provincial, local and income taxes associated with winning prize. Prize Winers will be required to furnish his/her social security number for the sole purpose of preparation of any tax forms as required by law.

GENERAL: Participating entrants assume all liability for and Released Parties shall be held harmless against any liability for any injury, losses or damages of any kind to persons, including personal injury or death, or injury to property caused or claimed to be caused in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, by participation in this Contest, acceptance, possession, or use/misuse of the prize, or any claims based on publicity rights, defamation or invasion of privacy, or merchandise delivery. Sponsor is not responsible for any

typographical or other error in the printing of the offer, administration of the Contest or in the announcement of the prize.

No confidential relationship is established by any Entrant and the Sponsor as a result of participating in the Contest. None of the information submitted by the Entrant will be treated as trade secrets, confidential information or as protected data.

In the event any participant engages or has engaged in behavior that (as determined by Sponsor in Sponsor's sole discretion) is obnoxious or threatening, illegal or that tends to annoy, abuse, threaten, disparage or harass any other person or company including the Sponsor or is otherwise inappropriate, the Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify the Entrant and void any Entries of said person.

In the event of a dispute over the identity of an entrant, entry will be deemed submitted by the "Authorized Account Holder" of the e-mail address submitted at time of entry. Authorized Account Holder means the natural person who is assigned to an e-mail address by an Internet access provider, online service provider, or other organization that is responsible for assigning e-mail addresses for the domain associated with the submitted e-mail address. Sponsor may ask any entrant or potential winner to provide Sponsor with proof, to Sponsor's satisfaction, that such party is the authorized account holder of the email address associated with the entry. Entry materials/data that have been tampered with or altered, or mass entries or entries generated by a script, macro or use of automated devices are void. The Released Parties are not responsible for: (i) lost, late, misdirected, damaged or illegible entries; or (ii) error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operations or transmission, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to or alterations of entry materials, or for technical, network, telephone equipment, electronic, computer, hardware or software malfunctions of any kind, or inaccurate transmission of or failure to receive entry information by Sponsor on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any web site or any combination thereof; or (iii) any injury or damage to entrant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participating in the Contest. DISPUTES: The parties hereto each agree to finally settle all disputes only through arbitration; provided, however, the Released Parties shall be entitled to seek injunctive or equitable relief in the state and federal courts in Dekalb County, Georgia and any other court with jurisdiction over the parties. In arbitration, there is no judge or jury and review is limited. The arbitrator's decision and award is final and binding, with limited exceptions, and judgment on the award may be entered in any court with jurisdiction. The parties agree that, except as set forth above, any claim, suit, action or proceeding arising out of or relating to this Contest shall be resolved solely by binding arbitration before a sole arbitrator under the streamlined Arbitration Rules Procedures of JAMS Inc. ("JAMS") or any successor to JAMS. In the event JAMS is unwilling or unable to set a hearing date within fourteen (14) days of the filing of a "Demand for Arbitration", then either party can elect to have the arbitration administered by the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") or any other mutually agreeable arbitration administration service. If an in-person hearing is required, then it will take place in Dekalb County, Georgia. The federal or state law that applies to these Official Rules will also apply during the arbitration. Disputes will be arbitrated only on an individual basis and will not be consolidated with any other proceedings that involve any claims or controversy of another party, including any class actions; provided, however, if for any reason any court or arbitrator holds that this restriction is unconscionable or unenforceable, then the agreement to arbitrate doesn't apply and the dispute must be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction in Dekalb County, Georgia. Sponsor agrees to pay the administrative and arbitrator's fees in order to conduct the arbitration (but specifically excluding any travel or other costs of entrant to attend the arbitration hearing). Either party may, notwithstanding this provision, bring qualifying claims in small claims court.

PRIVACY: As a condition of entering the Contest, each entrant gives consent for Sponsor to obtain and deliver his or her name, address and other information to third parties, including Administrator, for the purpose of administering this Contest and to comply with applicable laws, regulations and rules, including, without limitation, the storing of your personal information for purposes of complying with state record retention requirements. Any information entrant provides to Sponsor may be used to communicate with entrant in relation to this Contest or on a Contest winner's list.
